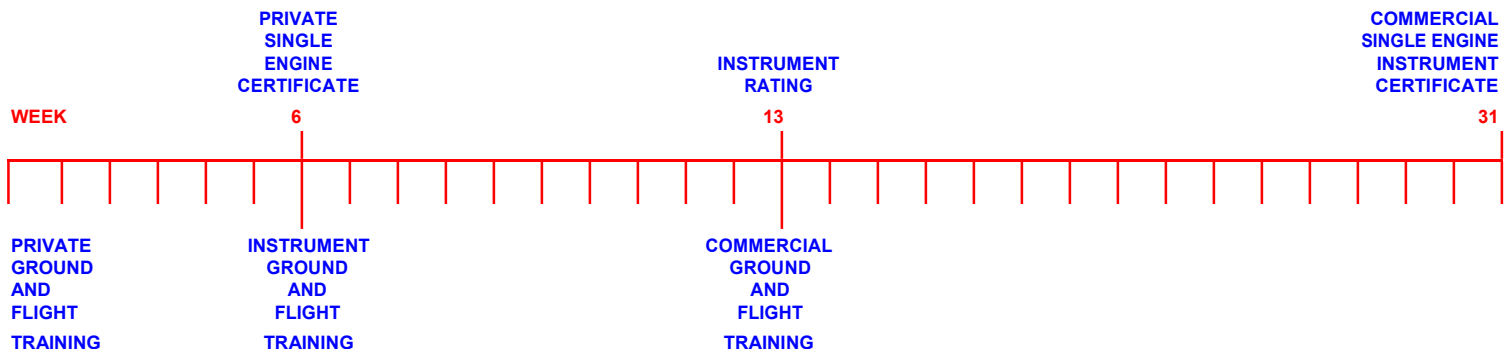

DIRECTIONS TO PARIS AIR, INC.

Traveling via 1-95, exit at Vero Beach, which is exit #147, and travel east on State Road 60 (also known as 20th Street) for approximately 5.3 miles. Turn north (left) at the traffic light on 43rd Avenue. Pass through the first traffic light and continue until you see the fire station on your right (0.4 miles). Your next right turn is Airport West Drive. Look for Paris Air, Inc. signs.

Traveling via US Highway 1, turn right (west) on Aviation Blvd. Proceed 1.9 miles and turn north (right) on 43rd Avenue and continue until you see the fire station on your right (0.4 miles). Your next right turn is Airport West Drive. Look for Paris Air, Inc. signs.

Traveling via the Florida Turnpike, exit at Yee-Haw Junction and travel east on State Road 60 (approximately 35 miles to the I-95 interchange) then follow the directions above. State Road 60 is also known as 20th Street.
